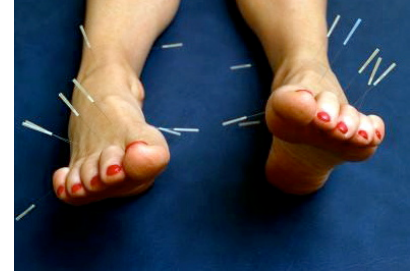


Introductory Course in Acupuncture for Dentists & DCPs



An interactive *all day* introductory course in acupuncture held at the Royal Society of Medicine, London, on Saturday 7th November 2009.

Acupuncture offers an effective and exciting treatment modality for Dentists and Dental Care Professionals.

This all day “hands on” meeting will consist of practical small group training to give confidence in the use of acupuncture. The use and scientific rationale of acupuncture will be discussed, with a strong emphasis on diagnosis and management of conditions suitable for treatment in general practice. You will have ample opportunity to practice new skills, and by the end of the day will be able to use acupuncture safely in the dental context. The course will be taught by an experienced dental acupuncturist, and limited to 14 participants to ensure personal practical tuition. *Not a day for needle phobics as you will be expected to practice on each other!*

Before the end of the day, you will have inserted many needles and be confident to try these procedures out.
